

**GEORGETOWN UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE
2008 ADVANCED STANDING APPLICATION PROCEDURES**

Applicants for admission with advanced standing must submit the following by May 15, 2008:

1. A completed 2007 Application for Admission with Advanced Standing. Applicants may apply for admission to either the second or third year.
2. A non-refundable application fee of \$130.00 (cashier check or money order, US currency only) payable to Georgetown University School of Medicine. **Personal checks and cash cannot be accepted.**
3. A one-page signed personal statement addressing the considerations which have stimulated your interest in Georgetown University School of Medicine, and your most fruitful and fulfilling experience to date.
4. Official transcripts from each undergraduate, graduate, and professional institution attended, including an official transcript listing the courses currently in progress, for all course work attempted/completed.
5. The applicant's scores on the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT). These scores must be forwarded to Georgetown from the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) through the online MCAT Testing History (THx) Report System. To access the MCAT THx System, go to:

6. A letter from the dean (or designee) of the school the applicant is currently attending, stating 1) that you are in good standing; and 2) that the application for transfer has the school's approval. If the medical school will not provide this credential, the applicant may request, in writing, that our Committee on Admissions accept a letter from the registrar's office stating that the applicant is enrolled at the school and is in good standing.
7. Two appraisals of character and ability from the applicant's medical school basic science professors in two different academic departments OR one basic science professor and one clinical professor. If available, please submit the evaluation of an undergraduate pre-medical committee. If no such evaluation can be obtained, indicate "no" at question 9.
8. Applicants to the Third Year Class must take and pass the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE), Step I. It is understood that most applicants to the Third Year Class will not yet have the results of this test when final decisions are made, so any offer of acceptance is contingent upon passing the USMLE, Step I. These test results must be submitted directly to the Office of Admissions from USMLE. The latest test date for this requirement is June 15, 2007.

The Committee on Admissions will only consider applications from applicants who submit all of the required credentials by our May 15, 2008 deadline. The School of Medicine assumes no obligation to inform the applicant of erroneous or missing credentials. Credentials submitted in support of an application become the property of the School of Medicine and will not be returned. Georgetown University School of Medicine reserves the right to pursue any questions regarding academic records and/or transcripts, or issues of concern raised during the application review.

REQUIRED EXAMINATIONS

1. All applicants must have official MCAT test scores from 2000 or later submitted directly to the Office of Admissions.
2. Applicants to the Third Year Class must take and pass Step I of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE). The latest test date for this requirement is June 15, 2008.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Only applicants who are in good standing at their present medical school will be considered.
2. Applicants for admission to the third year must be enrolled in a medical school accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME). Applicants to the second year must be enrolled in an LCME accredited program, or may be enrolled in a medical program in a school of osteopathic medicine in the United States.
3. All applicants for transfer must have completed, or be in the final process of completing, the equivalent of the School of Medicine's First and Second Year curricula. Please see the enclosed curriculum sheet.
4. Applicants for transfer may not request that recommendations from previous applications to Georgetown University School of Medicine be brought forward.
5. When an application is complete (i.e., all required credentials have been received) the file will be reviewed by the Committee on Admissions. Interviews at the School of Medicine are granted by invitation only and will be scheduled for early June – third year applicants; early July – second year applicants. Each applicant **must** include a telephone number and email address where he/she can be reached.
6. The Third Year Class begins in early July 2007, and the second year program starts in mid-August.
7. The tuition and fees assessed for the **2007 - 2008** academic year at the School of Medicine totaled \$42,764.00.
8. Individuals who have received the Ph.D., D.D.S., D.M.D., D.P.M., or D.V.M. degrees, or who are applicants for these degrees, will only be considered for admission to the First Year Class. Applications to the First Year Class are available from the *American Medical College Application Service (AMCAS)*, at the *AAMC website at www.aamc.org/amcas*.
9. The School of Medicine does not consider transfer applications for the First or Fourth Year Classes.
10. **No fee waivers will be granted.**
11. **The deadline for receipt of all credentials (including application and fee) is May 15, 2008. No extensions to this deadline will be made.**
